

III. Overview of the hospital

[Brief history of District Hospital Yingkiong]

The District Hospital Yingkiong was established in 1958 as Health Unit Yingkiong which was upgraded to Community Health Centre Yingkiong in 1989. The Community Health Centre Yingkiong was again upgraded to District Hospital Yingkiong in 1996 which was further upgraded to District Hospital with 50 bedded facilities on 12th August 2013. The District Hospital Yingkiong is the secondary healthcare centre of Upper Siang District which is located in left bank of the mighty Siang River at latitude 28.6419 degree North; longitude 95.0245 degree East and an altitude of 377 metres above sea level. The administration of the

 Hospital is look after by Medical Superintendent and the nursing staffs are headed by Nursing Superintendent.

The District Hospital Yingkiong offers a comprehensive range of services around the clock without any discrimination based on gender, sexuality, caste, socioeconomic status, race, colour, religious, stigmatize condition and language which includes-

a. Essential Services-

- i. General medicine: treatment of common & chronic illness
- ii. Surgery: general surgical procedures & trauma care
- iii. Obstetrics & Gynaecology: maternal & female reproductive health services
- iv. Paediatrics: care of infants & children
- v. Emergency & Trauma care: 24x7-all types of cases-medical, surgical, ENT, eye, orthopaedics, obstetrics, gynaecologic, paediatrics, psychiatrics, MLC etc.
- vi. Diagnostic Services: Laboratory testing, radiology (X-ray, USG, CT-Scan), ECG
- vii. Speciality Clinics-OPD services of ENT, Eye, Dental, Psychiatry
- viii. Maternal & Childcare: Antenatal care, deliveries and Postnatal care for mothers & newborns- JSSK
- ix. Rehabilitation Services: providing drug de-addiction services
- x. Immunization services: Immunized all beneficiaries 0 up to 5-7 years of age
- xi. Inpatient services: beds for patients who require overnight stay
- xii. Patient safety & Infection Control: implementation of protocol for the same
- xiii. Blood Bank Services: providing blood to the needy patient

b. Desirable Services-

- i. Newborn care services: SNCU, PICU
- ii. Dialysis: for patient with kidney failure
- iii. National Health Programme: treatment of HBV & HCV patients, NDD, IDCF etc
- iv. Public Health Functions: monitoring & control of communicable diseases like TB and non-communicable diseases like DM.
- v. Training Programme: providing refresher training to healthcare providers
- vi. Other Services; like doing postmortem; giving- death certificate, birth certificate, handicap certificate, CMAAY, AB-PMJAY.
